

The generosity of our parishioners helped to uplift our parish this year. The recordbreaking 2022 Diocesan Lenten Appeal supported outreach to seniors, infants and expectant mothers, and the sick and homebound. As the number of homeless rises in Western Pennsylvania, we will continue to need your support.

Thankfully our parish, and particularly our societies, are once again able to fundraise. This year, our monthly tickets, Super Bowl and Stanley Cup raffles, along with the Craft Show, Night at the Races and Cash Bash, were great successes! These events brought more than 200 people attending! It was wonderful to see so many people gathering as a community enjoying each other's company and having a good time.

We also hosted some great spiritual events such as the Saint Peregrine conference for cancer patients, and a beautiful Eucharistic procession on our grounds honoring the saints and their love of the Holy Eucharist. More spiritual events are planned in the upcoming months such as:

- Advent Penance Service and spiritual reflections
- Christmas Eve Masses and Christmas Day Mass
- Feast Day celebration for Mother Seton
